Disha Group Discussions: Six group discussions were held throughout the year on the following topics: 'How to Focus and Prioritize your Goals', 'Challenges in Communicating in English', 'Anxieties, Worries and Troubles', 'Social Issues in the Present Context', 'Young adults, family and relatives' and 'Struggles of living away from family'. Each discussion was attended by 30 to 40 students who eagerly participated in the discussion.

Disha Public Lectures: Lectures were held on topics such as, 'Diet, Fitness and Menstrual Health', by Dr. Sonali Talavalikar, 'How to use E resources in Research in Psychology', by Librarian, Sangeeta Dhamdhere, 'Encouraging Reading Skills' and 'Understanding Feminism' by Dr. Sadhana Natu. Amelia Ubesie, Doctoral Candidate from Penn State University, USA, gave a presentation on her Research Study about the activities of the Department of Psychology and her experience of interacting with the faculty and students.

Three Day Workshop titled 'Releshani' by Dr. Mohan Des from Arogya Bhan, 28th Aug to 30th Aug, 2017: Dr. Mohan Des, Social Activist conducted an intensive workshop addressing the topic of Relationships. The student turnout was huge and the response from the students was very good.

PSY WORLD III, 19th **Sept, 2017:** PSY WORLD III was inaugurated by Prof. B. R. Shejwal, Former Head, Department of Psychology, SPPU. There were many stalls, activities and Poster Presentations as well as PPT presentations. 277 students and 15 staff members attended the event.

Release of Kaleidoscope, 15th Dec, 2018: Dr. Sachin Shinde, PhD from London School of Tropical Medicine and Health and also an alumnus of the college released the magazine. He spoke to the students about the importance of writing and scientific writing.
