

1. Introduction

One more achievement we are proud of is that Maharashtra Energy Development Agency (MEDA) has honored us with a State level award for excellence in Energy Conservation and Management recognizing us as a Green Educational Institute.

The reports of the research outcome must be checked for the accuracy of the recorded data or observations, failing to which would be considered as a breach of research integrity. The data must be authentic and be based on the outcome of original activities of researcher and not from other sources, or with proper credit sharing or citations wherever necessary. Any intentional or

Research articles should preferably be published in UGC notified journals or the journals covered in Web-of-Science/Web-of-Social Science databases. Researchers should not publish the same research outcome in two different places to avoid duplication.

Mrs. Prachi Sathe effectively started her lecture by pointing out that humans are inherently different from other animals due their capacity of speaking. She further added that the use of cognitive ability of humans is the most advanced that helps us to feel different in different situations. She also effectively made a connection between human evolution and evolution of humans' brain capacity. She added that expressing one's own thoughts / having opinions positive or negative would reflect in the way they live their life and how that is one pune 16. of most important reasons why expressing is vital. She asserted that we tend to confine ourselves with people who think and feel the same way we do. This leads to development of no kind. Instead, it is more beneficial to engage in interesting and important conversations with elders, coming from myriad backgrounds and not just our peers. She encouraged the students to move beyond our comfort zones and seek these associations.

She further explained how our brains have two different compartments of Practical and Emotional and how connecting these both is essential in articulating better. Only concentrating on either practical or emotional is not beneficial. She further also ea process by which students can essentially build a good articulation skill.

The question and answer session brought out several important doubts the students had and it also made them more expressive. Dr. Megha Deshpande gave the vote of thanks by expressing gratitude towards the resource person and how this is just the beginning of a long standing collaboration. She also thanked The Vice Principal and HOD Dr. Jyoti Suhas Gagangras for her guidance and help in organising the program and other faculty members and colleagues for their help and support.


