Desai College of Arts, Science and Commerce (Autonomous), Pune.

On behalf of the Indian Council of Chemists, we have great pleasure in inviting you to attend all the functions and participation in the deliberations to be conducted under scientific sessions of Inorganic, Organic, Physical and Analytical & Environmental Chemistry Sections and symposium as well.

The Conference would provide an excellent opportunity to researchers for presenting new experimental results and participating in scientific discussion/debate in different areas of Chemistry. The Conference shall provide an opportunity for a meaningful interactions among the members of the scientific fraternity.

REGISTRATION

All participants are required to register in advance by sending a registration fee of Rs. 2500 (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) by November 30, 2024.

All authors contributing a paper must be fellow of the Council. Their fellowship fee for the year 2024 must be paid, otherwise the paper will not be considered for presentation. Annual fellowship fee is Rs. 600/- (Six hundred only) and Life Fellowship is Rs. 6000/- (Six thousand only). The fee be paid by Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'Indian Council of Chemists' payable at Agra, which should be sent to Treasurer, ICC.

Note: All authors contributing a paper in the Conference must be Fellows of the Council. (Annual fellowship fee Rs 600/- for the 2024 or life fellowship fee Rs. 6000/- must be paid along with the submission of the abstract.)
