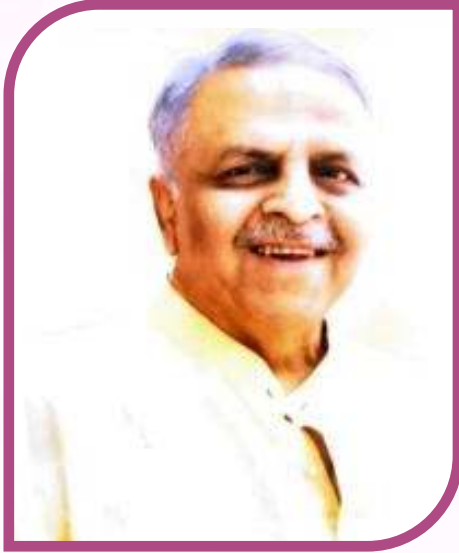

Students need to purchase 'Admission guidelines /Prospectus from college office to get unique ID to be entered in online admission

- . A student passing in all subjects at S.Y. level, but failing in any subject at F.Y. level and physical Exam cannot be admitted to TY level of U.G. courses of any faculty.
- a. Students migrating from another National/International university or board with ATPT/ATKT shall not be eligible for admission in the next higher class of the course selected in SPPU, Pune.
- b. Students qualifying First Year examination of the UG program from any other university and having qualified 10 + 2 pattern Certificate Examination are eligible for seeking admission to second/Third year Degree Program of SPPU, Pune, if equivalence (Subject to final decision of Equivalence Committee of SPPU, Pune) is Satisfactory.
- c. Students migrating from another university and admitted to Third Year of three year degree course of SPPU, Pune or second year of post-graduation of SPPU, Pune will get pass class only.

- Students seeking admission should enter all the required information in the prescribed admission form and no column in the form should be left blank.

- Nature of Intake Capacity(seats)
 - o Other State: maximum 10% of sanctioned intake capacity.
 - o NRI: maximum 10% of sanctioned intake capacity through SPPU Student Centre.
 - o Foreign Students/Foreign Nationals/PIO: Maximum 15% over and above the sanction is made by the International Student Centre, SPPU.
 - o Jammu & Kashmir Migrants: 02 seats under the supplementary quota above the sanctioned intake capacity.
 - o Reservation
 - . 52% seats of the overall sanctioned intake capacity are reserved for the reserved students from the state of Maharashtra.
 - a. 19% seats of the overall sanctioned intake capacity are reserved for Other Backward Caste Candidates.
 - b. 13% seats of the overall sanctioned intake capacity are reserved for Schedule Caste Candidates.
 - c. 7% seats of the overall sanctioned intake capacity are reserved for Schedule Tribes Candidates.
 - d. 11% seats of the overall sanctioned intake capacity are reserved for Nomadic Tribes.
 - e. 3% seats of the overall sanctioned intake capacity are reserved for differently abled Candidates.
 - f. Amongst the differently abled candidates – 1% each is sanctioned for visually impaired, orthopedic disorder and students with hearing and speech impediments.
 - g. Candidates who belong to Special backward Class (SBC) will be offered reservation upto 2% seats available for Maharashtra Candidates. No separate seats are earmarked.

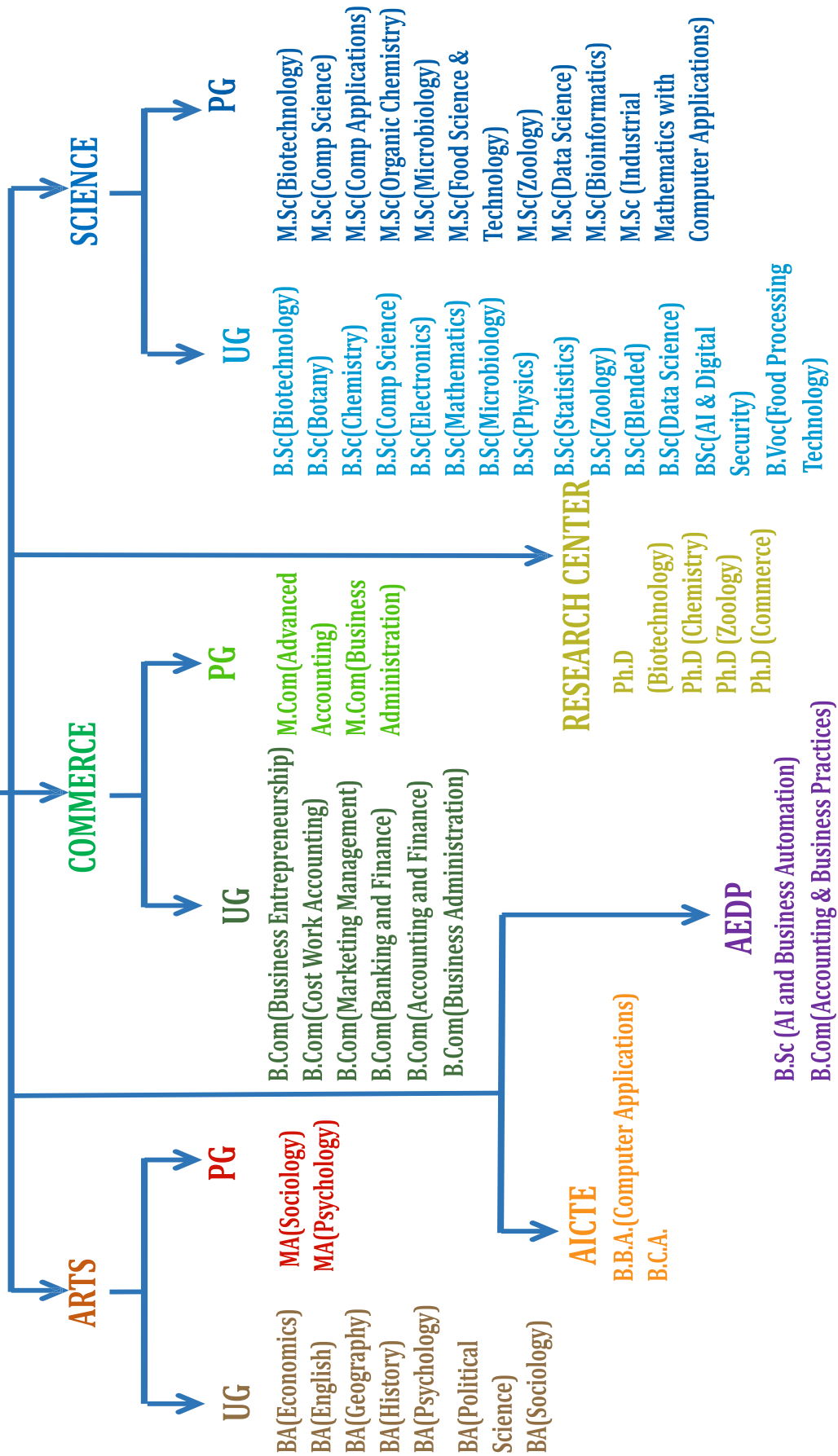

Code of Conduct: Disciplinary Rules

Disciplinary Rules

- As per the UGC draft, regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher education institutions, 2009, every student and parent will have to fill, sign and submit an undertaking to refrain from ragging along with the admission form.
- The Internal Committee (Anti Sexual Harassment Committee) functions as per the guidelines of the POSH Act, 2013 for the security of female staff and students.
- Students may reach out to the Anti-Ragging Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell and Internal Complaint Committee in case of any issues.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited on campus.
- As per the Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) rules, a minimum of 75 % attendance is essential, failing to which action will be taken as per the rules.
- The student shall park the vehicle in the parking space provided by the college and pay the charges.
- The four-wheeler parking for students is strictly prohibited.
- The student shall not consume tobacco, drugs, pan parag, gutkha, liquor and other things which are injurious to health.
- The student should keep their mobile on silent mode while in the classrooms and on the campus.
- It is compulsory to wear an I-card on the college campus.

Maintenance of Discipline and Good Conduct by students - Ordinance 157 (as per section 87 & section 39 (III) of Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 1994).

Every student at Modern College at all the times:

- i. Conduct himself properly and maintain proper behaviour.
- ii. Observe strict discipline both at the college campus, at playgrounds and outside, in buses, trains, or in public places or at picnics or education trips arranged by the college.
- iii. Ensure that no act, consciously or unconsciously brings the college into disrepute.
- iv. Shall not lodge any complaint or make any representation regarding any matter connected with the college to the press or other media.

5. Obstruction to any student or group of students in his or their legitimate activities whether in the classroom, laboratory, field, playground, gymnasium or place of social and cultural activity within the campus of the college.
6. Possessing or using firearms, lethal weapons, explosives or dangerous / corrosive / poisonous / stupefying drug or intoxicant in any form in the college.
7. Ragging, bullying or harassing any other student in the college or outside thereof or the authorities of the college or to the staff member or any member of the family of the staff.
8. Indulging in the act of violence, assault, intimidation or threatening in the college or outside thereof.
9. Destroying or attempting to destroy or tamper with any official record or document of the college.
10. Conduct unbecoming of the student at any meeting or special function or sports and cultural activities arranged by the college or at any other public place.
11. Stealing or damaging any property belonging to the college, staff member of the college or any other students.
12. Instigation or participating in any gherao of any official or staff member of the college.
13. Violation of any rules and regulations of the college or orders of the authority.

15. Refusal to appear to give evidence before the enquiry officer appointed by the authority with respect to a charge against him.

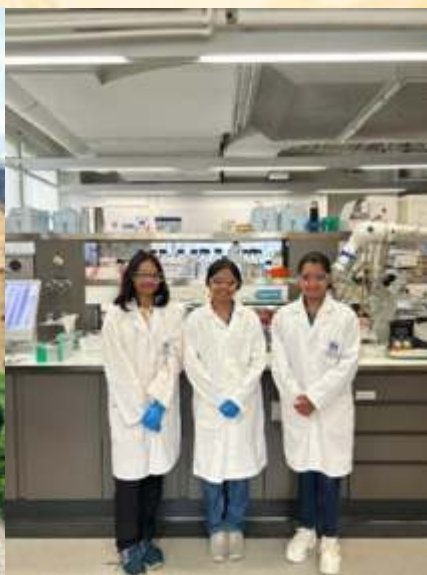

At the beginning of the academic year orientation session regarding Examination Rules, Policies are conducted class wise which will be helpful for the students to understand the examination system.

Various sessions regarding awareness of ABC Id, NAD data will be taken in the beginning of the academic year. Assistance to students is provided to generate ABC Id and any queries related to it.

General Instructions

- Every student must open a Digilocker account on their mobile.
- A Student must obtain an eligibility certificate before filling the examination form.
- After declaration of results college notifies about filling online rechecking (Photocopy of answer sheets) / revaluations forms
- The passing percentage in all subjects is 40 %.
- ATKT rules are applicable as per SPPU norms.
- Internal examinations will be conducted only once per semester / term.
- All the first-year level (F.Y.) examinations will be conducted by the college itself as per the University guidelines.
- Students of First year of all the faculties must appear for the **Physical Education examination**. The students who do not fulfill this criteria are not permitted to appear for the Annual Examination. **Examination-related notices are made available on the college website.**
- **Medical check-ups** are compulsory for students of first year from all the faculties. Students who do not fulfill this norm will not be permitted to appear for the annual examination.
- Students appearing for the examination must follow the instructions below:

A. While entering the examination hall

1. Make sure that you are not in possession of any material such as books, notebooks, scribbled notes, mobile, etc., which may tempt you to copy or use as a reminder.
2. Do not take away any answer book or supplement (written or blank) while leaving the examination hall.
3. Do not speak or communicate in any way with any other candidate in the examination hall while the examination is going on.
4. Do not disobey any instruction/s issued to you by the Senior or Junior Supervisor.
5. Do not behave in a rude or disobedient manner. Failure to observe the instructions may result in expelling the candidate instantly and punishing misconduct or breach of rules by excluding the candidate from any University or College Examination or Course for a specified period or permanently.

B. While writing in the examination hall

1. Write on both sides of the answer book.
2. Write the answer- books in blue or black ink/ball pen only. Use of coloured pencil or ink in case of diagrams and sketches is permitted.
3. Do not write your name in any part of your answer book or disclose your identity in any other manners.
4. Do not write anything on your question paper or the blotting paper.
5. Do not write your seat number anywhere except in the space provided. If the seat number is written anywhere else, it will be treated as 'unfair means' and the performance will be treated as null and void for the entire examination.
6. Address all your queries to your supervisor, do not leave your Seat on any account.
7. If you suspect that there is some error in the question paper, immediately bring it to the notice of the Senior Supervisor to enable him/ her to rectify it after making the necessary enquiries. In case the Senior Supervisor is unable to rectify the error while the paper is in progress, you should bring the suspected error to the notice of the Chief Conductor of the Examination centre immediately.
8. Write your answer in legible handwriting. Answers written in illegible and indecipherable handwriting are liable to be unassessed.
9. In case a part of the answer to a question is written on a page, not immediately succeeding the page on which the main body of the answer is written, the fact must be clearly indicated at the end of the complete answer, otherwise the part of the answer is liable to remain unassessed.
10. You will not be permitted to leave the examination hall until half an hour after the question papers are distributed, and during the last 10 minutes of the scheduled time

given for the particular examination.
