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Following business was transacted -

1. Minutes of previous meeting were approved by the members.
2. Review of recommendations given by Peer Team and action taken thereon was discussed as follows -
 - (a) Regarding introduction of new PG and UG programs-
It was decided to apply for PG programs in Psychology and Geography to the earliest. Being located in Metropolitan City, available space is a limiting factor. Therefore starting other courses seems difficult.
 - (b) Regarding Skill development courses -
Members discussed on feasibility of starting new skill development courses. It was decided to start few skill development courses eg. Vedic Mathematics, Mushroom Cultivation, Vermi-composting etc.

(c) Library be enriched ---
After 3rd accreditation 692 text books and 1578 reference books were purchased till date. It was also decided to further enrich library in the coming academic year.

(d) More research centers ---
Research centers in Biotechnology and Chemistry were started.

(e) Encourage faculties to complete Ph.D. ...
Five faculties have completed their Ph.D. post accreditation. Some more are about to complete their research in this academic year.

(f) Additional space for Laboratories ...
It was decided to construct few more laboratories to accommodate the proposed programs and additional requirements of existing programs.

(g) Consultancy and Collaboration ...
It was decided to establish and strengthen the collaboration and linkages with various research institutes and industries for Collaborative research, exchange, training and placement as follows -

Collaborations for Research - Vasantdada Sugar Institute, Environmental science department, SPPU, BARC Mumbai, RMIT University, Melbourne, Australia, MGM Institute of Health Science, Mumbai.

Collaborations for Placements - Athena Consultancy, RASA Life science Informatics, Toxindia.

(h) Facilities for differently abled students ...
It was suggested by the members to establish a separate computer laboratory for visually impaired students. It was also decided to make some recorded lectures and braille books available in the library to fulfil the needs of visually impaired students.
