Future Bankers Forum has conducted **Mock Parliament on passing the bill on Bank Nationalisation** on 27th Aug 2018, Monday. In the syllabus of the second year there is a topic of Bank Nationalisation. The forum decided to conduct the activity based learning on the arguments for and against the bank nationalisation. The guest lecture of Mrs. Gauri Kopardekar, Head of Politics Department was organised on the technical session of the parliament on the same day at 8.30am to 9am to know the process of the parliament. The auditorium was converted into the parliament under the guidance of Mrs.Kopardekar Madam.

The whole class was divided into two groups i.e. Ruling Party and opposition party group for the debate on arguments for and against bank nationalisation.
